

Project Goals

Safety improvements for ALL users

Traffic calming (slower vehicle speeds) in neighborhood

 Consider additional bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure where possible, which also helps encourage healthy exercise and recreation



Project Approach

• Quick-build focus (paint, flex posts, signage, etc.)

• A look to the future in making quick-build projects permanent (e.g. with curbing)



What We Heard

- May 8, 2023 Public Workshop
- Other engagement included: mailers, emails, and calls
- Takeaways include:
 - Concerns in <u>all</u> areas on <u>all</u> streets. Comprehensive and thoughtful process required to identify locations
 - Urgency of the issue. Quick response to most critical areas first
 - Concern for overall aesthetic
 - And more...






Project Approach


- All-way Stop: Review locations to ensure consistency based on a) safety,
 b) school locations and c) traffic patterns
- 2. Speed Control Spacing: 500-ft max spacing (per Federal Highway Administration) with more frequent countermeasures near schools
- 3. Bicycle Network Facilities: Review Hartford Bike Plan and align with area characteristics
- 4. Unique Areas: Review unique intersection at a) Granby and Cornwall, b) Cornwall and Lyme, and c) Lyme, Pembroke, and Palm


Note on Speed Limits: Recommend 25 MPH for all streets (Tower, Cornwall, Granby, and Coventry reduction in Speed Limit)

































Lateral Shift






Diagram Example with Vertical Elements to Enforce Shift



Granby Street

- Narrower Travel Lanes (10-ft)
- Bike Lanes in Both Directions
- Parking
 - West side only south of Weaver HS
 - Both sides near Cronin Park
- Bumpouts at all stop controlled / signalized intersections (6 locations)
- 7 additional treatments in segment (Lateral Shifts or Pinch Points)



Cornwall Street

- Granby and Cornwall Gateway
- Cornwall and Lyme Mini-Roundabout
- Bumpouts at all stop-controlled intersections (6 locations)
- Bike lanes between Granby and Lyme (Parking west side)
- 6 additional treatments in segment (Mini Islands and Pinch Points)
- Centerline Removal with Edgelines Lyme to Manchester
 - Parking both sides to Holcomb
 - Alternating between Tower and Holcomb



Lyme Street

- Full Closure north of Pembroke to limit through traffic
- 6 stop-controlled intersections with bumpouts
- 3 additional treatments in segment (Mini Islands)
- Bike Sharrows between Cornwall and Pembroke



Palm Street

- Full Closure north of Pembroke to limit through traffic
- 3 stop-controlled intersections with bumpouts
- 6 additional treatments in segment (Mini Islands)
- Hardened Centerline at Manchester Street (near curve)
- Centerline removal north of Durham Street
- Bike Sharrows between Pembroke Street and Morningside Street West



Coventry Street

- South of Tower
 - Bike Sharrows
 - Bumpouts at Branford (new stop) and Holcomb
 - 6 additional treatments in segment (Pinch Points)
- Review of Tower / Coventry intersection lane arrangements



Coventry Street

- North of Tower
 - Narrower Travel Lanes (10-ft)
 - Bike Lanes in Both Directions
 - Parking West side only
 - Bumpouts at all stop controlled intersections (2 locations)
 - 2 additional treatments in segment (Mini island and pinch point)



Tower Avenue


- Mini island similar to Wethersfield Avenue at select location to prevent illegal usage of middle lane
- Bumpouts at Barbour Street





Granby Street (Garfield to Chatham)






Granby Street (Plainfield to Westminister)






Granby Street (Durham to Burnham)








Cornwall Street (Garfield to Hebron)






Cornwall Street (Hebron to Holcomb)








Street "Program" View — Lyme St (Cornwall to Holcomb)




Street "Program" View — Palm St (Manchester to Harold)












Median Island


- Narrows the travel lanes at that location
