

WHEREAS, on the 5th day of August, 2021, Governor Ned Lamont issued Executive Order No. 13A pursuant to emergency declarations of the Governor and in accordance with the requirements of Special Act 21-5, which among other things authorizes individual municipalities "to require masks or face coverings in indoor settings regardless of vaccination status" pursuant to Sec. 28-8a of the Connecticut General Statutes (Municipal chief executive officers' powers during emergency); and

WHEREAS, on September 27, 2021, the House of Representatives adopted HR 302 in Special Session and on September 28, 2021, the Senate adopted SR 76 in Special Session, extending the emergency declaration of Governor Ned Lamont until February 15, 2022, pursuant to Special Act 21-5; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hartford issued a mask mandate pursuant to this authority via Executive Order dated October 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hartford has seen significant declines in the number of positive COVID-19 cases within our boundaries and our region;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Hartford's Executive Order dated October 1, 2021 is hereby terminated, effective immediately.
