STATEMENT OF PURPOSE AND NEED FOR THE PROPOSAL: [40 CFR 1508.9(B)]

To rehabilitate a blighted and underdeveloped property in Hartford's Upper Albany neighborhood.

The project, Magnolia Building, is located at 635-651 Albany within the Upper Albany neighborhood of the City of Hartford, CT.

The project will entail rehabilitation and improvements to 12 apartments that require extensive rehabilitation. All the residential units will have new energy efficient windows, floors, doors, kitchen cabinets and countertops, bathroom fixtures, bathtubs, and vanities. New energy efficient HVAC system.

The existing three commercial store spaces will be converted into four commercial spaces. The commercial space will have new store fronts constructed along with new signs and metal awnings. New exterior lighting. On the interior of the commercial space, new ceilings will be installed to meet the up-to-date fire rating codes between the commercial and residential floors of the building. The commercial space will also have new flooring installed and a new HVAC system.

Construction is anticipated to commence in January 2022 with a construction duration of approximately 6 months.

The State Historic Preservation Office has reviewed the information submitted for the above-named property pursuant to the provisions of Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 and Connecticut Environmental Policy Act.

The property located at 635-651 Albany Avenue (Magnolia Apartments, Storrs & Feinberg, 1925) is a contributing resource to the National Register of Historic Places (NR) listed Upper Albany Historic District (NR# 86003383).

Your proposal includes rehabilitation of the Subject Property, including replacement of existing storefronts, repointing of masonry, interior rehabilitation, and repairs to cast stone trim elements.

In accordance with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Hisotirc Properties, new ornamental trim should be differentiated from existing, historic trim, so as not to give a false sense of historicity. Note that care should be taken in the cleaning, repointing, and repair of historic masonry materials. Regarding the repair to cast stone elements, please refer to the National Park Service's Preservation Brief# 42: The Maintenance, Repair and Replacement of Historic Cast Stone. Regarding repointing, replacement mortar should match the original in color, strength, porosity, and tooling profile; please refer to Preservation Brief #2: Repointing Mortar Joints in Historic Masonry Buildings, for appropriate materials and techniques. Lastly, cleaning should be accomplished using the gentlest means possible; please refer to Preservation Brief #1: Cleaning and Water-Repellent Treatments for Historic Masonry Buildings, and Preservation Brief #6: Dangers of Abrasive Cleaning to Historic Buildings, for further information on appropriate techniques.



Contingent on the undertaking following the recommendations above, SHPO has determined that the scope of work will constitute <u>no adverse effects</u> to historic resources. Should the scope of work change, this office should be contacted for additional consultation.

Turner Environmental, LLC has completed supplemental research and limited environmental sampling of soil vapor sampling and soil at the above-referenced property. Our findings are presented here.

A Phase I environmental Site Assessment was completed for the property, report dated April 13, 2020. The finding identified:

- An on-site historical suspected dry cleaner, and
- An adjacent historical dry cleaner

The possibility that the site was previously occupied by a dry cleaner was based on references in a city directory that showed Best Cleaners and Formal Wear occupied the site from at least 1951 through at least 1956; this tenant may have been present from 1947 through 1974. In addition a potential Vapor Encroachment Concern (VEC) is posed by a neighboring property that operated as a dry cleaner within the VEC distance guidelines.

In order to evaluate these concerns, Turner performed additional research on records for the property, interviewed the current owner of "Best Cleaners" and interviewed a number of people familiar with the operations on-site including the current owner and a number of residents of the apartment building located on-site and in the surrounding neighborhood during the time period in question. Copies of the interview questionnaires used for this purpose are provided in Attachment A.

Turner also reviewed records for Hazardous Waste generation at the site and for the abutting property. No hazardous waste was identified as being generated on-site. Hazardous wastes including waste from dry cleaning operations were found for the abutting property during its operational period.

Based on a review of the available information and records, it appears that **no dry cleaning was previously performed on-site**. This is based on interviews with the current owner; a telephone interview with the owner of Best Cleaners (Shawn McCann, President) who indicated that Best Cleaners operates approximately a dozen dry cleaning stores in the Hartford area but did not operate any dry cleaning operations on the subject property at any time in the past.

Based on the available information, Turner also tested both soil vapor from beneath the building and soil samples from beneath the concrete floor in the area previously reported to house the "Best Cleaners and Formal Wear".

Turner tested five soil samples from the basement area reportedly occupied by the "potential Dry Cleaner". Soil sampling was performed on July 6, 2020. No contaminants of concern were found that suggest that any dry cleaning compounds were released or used in the basement area. Although some low concentrations of other typical urban contaminants were found in soil, all were below their respective CT DEEP Clean-up Criteria and do not pose a threat to human health and the environment. A copy of the analytical laboratory report for soil

analyses is provided in Attachment B

Based on the proximity of Thrifty Cleaners, a former dry cleaner on the abutting property this use poses a potential Vapor Encroachment condition as the former dry cleaner is only about ten feet of the property line A soil vapor sample vapor was obtained from beneath the basement floor from the eastern portion of the building to evaluate the VEC posed by the abutting former dry cleaner.

Turner performed the soil vapor sampling on June 18, 2020. A small 3/8 inch diameter hole was drilled through the concrete floor in the floor of the building. A soil vapor sample was collected by inserting a stainless steel tube through the floor into the soil to a depth of approximately 0.5 feet below the floor. The tube was sealed into the hole with plumbers putty and the penetration was leak checked. A soil vapor sample was obtained from beneath the floor using a six liter "Summa" canister with a 30 minute regulator.

The summa canister was submitted to York Analytical Laboratories in Stratford, Connecticut for analyses. The results identified several volatile organic compounds above the laboratory detection limits. These included low concentrations of Tetrachloroethylene, trichloroethylene and Carbon tetrachloride which are likely the result of releases from the abutting dry cleaning operations. **The concentration of Tetrachlorethylene exceeds its CT DEEP Residential Soil Vapor Criteria.** In addition a number of other volatile organic compounds (VOCs) were detected in the soil vapor, likely from the urban nature of the area. These included 1,2,4-Trimethylbenzene, 1,3,5-Trimethylbenzene, 1,4-Dichlorobenzene, 2-Butanone, Acetone, Dichlorodifluoromethane, Ethyl Benzene, Isopropanol, Methylene chloride, n-Heptane, n-Hexane, o-Xylene, p- & m- Xylenes, Styrene, and Trichlorofluoromethane (Freon 11). All concentrations of these additional compounds were well below their respective CT DEEP Criteria for soil vapor.

The results are summarized ion Table 1 and a copy of the Laboratory Analytical report is provided in Attachment C

Based on the results, there are VEC Conditions present for the subject property resulting from the former abutting dry cleaner.

The concrete floor in the basement of the building is in poor condition which could allow for the infiltration of soil vapor to enter the building. Based on the concentrations found we recommend repairing the concrete floor of the building after adding a layer of crushed stone and a plastic vapor barrier with installation of a sub-slab depressurization system with an active fan to prevent any soil vapor from entering the basement of the building. The system should be run continuously and monitored weekly for proper operation.

Based on our review of additional information, the site does not appear to have operated as a "dry cleaner" or any of the other conditional operations nor has any Hazardous Waste been generated on site that would make the site an "Establishment" pursuant to the Connecticut Property transfer Program. No filings would be necessary with the CT DEEP at the time of the next transfer of tittle for the property.
