


COMPLETE STREETS FUND



This fund is supported by planning and zoning fees, particularly those associated with billboard conversion and parking lot modifications. This fund is intended to support Complete Streets efforts, be it comms, design, build-out, etc.

On 1/10/23, the Planning & Zoning Commission (PZC) adopted a zoning code amendment to regulate and review the Complete Streets Fund budget on an annual basis. The adopted process includes budget development by DDS, input from DPW, public comment, PZC recommendations, and processing approval by OMBGA/Finance/COO.

Prior to 2023, funding was used to support outreach, grant matching, streetscape design, and DominGO! Open Streets.

Build-out / Implementation

- Implement quick-build pilots and demo showcases for proof of concept and buy-in
- Issue small grants for community-led projects
- Add Micromobility amenities





Grant Matchine

- Support grant matching for Riverwalk S and Keney Park trail projects
- Remaining funds roll over for future years






