Safe Streets - Pilot Project Traffic Calming at Garden & Greenfield



PURPOSE

Earlier this year, Garden and Greenfield streets were identified as a priority area based on crash and safety needs.

To take quick and meaningful action, the Safe Streets team will be using safety treatments that have worked in other areas of Hartford.

WHAT TO EXPECT

The installation will include restriped lane lines and flexible post bumpouts (see photo example below).

You may see the team in the street in the next few weeks as they install the project (late Oct - early Nov). Measuring and marking with paint will occur in advance of installation.
