





- A mini-grant program that supports residents who have ideas on how to make a difference in their community
- A neighborhood beautification/quality of life improvement program
- An opportunity to see your ideas come to life



- Tree planting









- Painting walls










- Feedback is given to ideas that are close and need small tweaks
- Invited to Officially Apply for Grant Opportunity CANNOT SHARE LINK

## LYB Resident Grant

- Resident-led
- Project completed by October 2024
- Up to \$2,500 in funding
- Application through City of Hartford

## LYB Community Grant

• Led by or informed by residents but with a nonprofit partner • Up to \$25,000 in funding Application through Hartford Foundation for Public Giving

## **The Review Process**

- Grant applications are reviewed and scored by community groups
  - Project Proposal (25 points)
  - Community Engagement (25 points)
  - Budget (20 points)
  - Metrics & Impact (10 points)
  - Sustainability Plan (20 points)
- The recommended projects are submitted to Hartford Foundation for final approval
- Past Project Lead and Grant Reviewer Janine McMahon






