I. Letter From the Chair of CPRB

Dear Mayor Arulampalam, Council President Clarke II, members of the Court of Common Council, and the residents of Hartford,

As Acting Chair of the Civilian Police Review Board, I'm proud to pass along on behalf of the Office of the Inspector General and my fellow CPRB commissioners our 2025 Annual Report, as required by Hartford Municipal Code, Chapter 2, Article V, Division 5, Section 2-196(e). This report summarizes the work that CPRB has accomplished over the last year, and I hope also points towards continued positive momentum as we enter 2026.

The role of a CPRB commissioner, while volunteer, is not one to be taken lightly. The CPRB has the power to invoke real-world consequences on both our fellow civilians and on Hartford Police Department, whether positive or negative, depending on the effectiveness of how we operate. CPRB's overarching goal is to provide Hartford residents who have had what they perceive to be negative interactions with the Hartford Police Department with a structured and independent mechanism to have their complaints assessed and publicly heard, promoting transparency, equity, and fairness of outcomes. Additionally, this independent review ensures that HPD is performing its duties in compliance with the law and its own Code of Conduct and is being respectful to the general populace as they go about their regular activities in the city. The Board seeks to use the power it has been legally granted to continuously improve police-civilian relations, which ultimately benefits everyone in Hartford in the long run.

Overall, 2025 has been a year of reflection for the Board, as we are now just over 5 years beyond the implementation of the revised Ordinance, intended to enable the Board to move beyond simply an advisory role, into one of more authority, via resourcing a full-time Inspector General's Office and granting the CPRB incremental legal powers, including subpoena power and binding independent arbitration when the Chief's analysis of civilian allegations differs from that of the CPRB's. As we have looked back over the last 5 years, we have been heartened by our significant advances in Board process, transparency, consistency, and overall effectiveness. Also, CPRB is now staffed with 9 commissioners who are committed and diligent in their tasks, ensuring that complaints are swiftly, but conscientiously reviewed and voted upon during our regular monthly public meetings.

But, at the same time as we can point to these successes, it also must be noted that key provisions of the 2020 amendments to the CPRB Ordinance have yet to be fully realized, in particular the implementation of the arbitration process. To date we have 2 cases that have been on the arbitration docket -- one for just under 7 months and the other for over 4 and a half months -- but without a fully-realized practical process to actually allow the arbitrator (a retired judge who has previously been vetted through the process required in the Ordinance and who is willing to serve the City of Hartford in this role) to perform his independent review.

2026, therefore, presents an opportunity to take CPRB to the next level, and my fellow commissioners and I are committed to significant strategic goals for the year:

- Continuing to enhance the transparency and consistency of the end-to-end civilian complaint review process
- Piloting the arbitration process with the 2 pending docketed complaints
- Developing a more systematic strategy for better Board community visibility and civilian outreach/advocacy
- Identifying ways that we can more strategically and effectively interact with our key city partners, including the Chief of Police, HPD IA, the mayor's office, the Office of Violence Prevention, and other community allies

Thank you in advance for your time and attention in reviewing the enclosed report, and please do not hesitate to reach out to me or the Inspector General with any questions, concerns, or follow-ups at any time.

II. CPRB's Mandate and Authority

The City of Hartford has maintained a Civilian Police Review Board (CPRB) since 1992. Its Board was established by City Ordinance,¹ which clearly states the City Council's intent in creating the CPRB. The Ordinance states:

“It is in the interest of Hartford residents and citizens, generally, and of the Hartford Police Department. It is in the interest of Hartford residents and citizens, generally, and of the Hartford Police Department that investigations of complaints concerning misconduct by police officers involving members of the public be complete, thorough and impartial. These inquiries must be conducted fairly and independently, and in such a manner that the public and the police department have confidence.”

For many years, CPRB reviewed citizen complaints and issued findings; however, those findings were not enforceable, and the Board mainly served an advisory role. In November 2020, in response to the murder of George Floyd and the nationwide outrage over systemic police misconduct, the City Council amended the CPRB ordinance to strengthen the Board's authority and establish genuine accountability.

The 2020 amendments expanded the Board's investigatory powers by establishing an Inspector General with subpoena authority, required the Chief of Police to consider the CPRB's findings when deciding if an officer violated the Code of Conduct, including civil rights violations and all general orders, and granted enforcement power by creating a right to binding arbitration when the Chief's findings differ from those of the CPRB.

Hartford is the only city in Connecticut with a full-time Inspector General dedicated to civilian police oversight, and its ordinance provides the strongest accountability framework of any civilian police review board in the state.

III. How to File a Citizen Complaint

Anyone, whether they are a resident of the City of Hartford or not, who believes they were mistreated by a Hartford Police Department officer or witnessed misconduct, can file a formal complaint against that officer. To do so, the individual must fill out a Citizen Complaint Form, which is available in both English and Spanish. The form can be obtained on the City of Hartford's website, at City Hall, the Office of the Inspector General in Suite 300, or at the Hartford Police Department.

A complaint can be submitted online,² by phone,³ in person,⁴ or by mail.⁵ Once a complaint is filed, a copy is sent to the Hartford Police Department's Internal Affairs Division, and a separate copy is sent to the Civilian Police Review Board (CPRB). Each organization conducts its own independent investigation into the allegations.

Complaints submitted to the CPRB are investigated by the Office of the Inspector General on behalf of the Board. This investigation is independent of, and occurs simultaneously with, the Internal Affairs investigation.

At the end of the citizen complaint investigation, a member of the Office of the Inspector General presents their findings to the CPRB during a public meeting. The Board then reviews the complaint and decides whether to sustain or not sustain the allegations against the involved police officer(s).

If the Board, by majority vote, sustains one or more allegations against one or more police officers, the Inspector General forwards both the Board's findings and the Inspector General's investigative report to the Chief of Police for review. According to City Ordinance, the Chief of Police must examine both the CPRB Inspector General's report and the Internal Affairs report when deciding whether to sustain or not sustain the allegations.

If the Chief of Police does not sustain an allegation that the Board has sustained, the Board may proceed to binding arbitration. Binding arbitration is a process in which the CPRB and the Chief of Police, through their respective representatives, present their findings to a retired judge, who then issues a final decision on whether to sustain or not sustain the allegation(s). The arbitrator's ruling is final and cannot be appealed.


IV. Information and Data Required in the Annual Report

Hartford’s CPRB Ordinance requires the Civilian Police Review Board to submit an annual report to the Court of Common Council and the mayor’s office.⁶ This report is submitted by the Inspector General on behalf of the Civilian Police Review Board to the mayor and council members, detailing the number and types of allegations received by the Board and making this information available to the public, as required under the CPRB Ordinance.

The CPRB Ordinance requires that the CPRB annual report detail the following:

1. The type and number of complaints filed.

In 2025, there were 61 complaints with a total of 232 allegations. The frequency of various complaint categories is shown below.

2. The number and identity of police officers complained against and the number and identity of police officers against whom multiple complaints were received and the disposition of those complaints.

a. The number and identity of officers complained against in 2025.

In 2025, complaints were filed against sixty-one (61) police officers. Of these, ten (10) officers faced more than one complaint. The complete list of officers accused of violations in the calendar year 2025 is provided below. Officers with multiple allegations are highlighted in red, with the number of complaints displayed next to their names.

CPRB provides this data as required by the Ordinance but offers the following clarification to avoid misinterpretation: The list below identifies officers with multiple allegations in red font; however, this does not mean that the Board sustained allegations against all the officers shown in red. The list of officers for whom the Board did sustain allegations is on page 10.

3. The identity of police officers with either:

a. More than two complaints in 2025.

The Board sustained allegations against Officer Albuquerque in two complaints (one in 2024 and one in 2025) but did not in a third complaint. No allegations were sustained against Officer Clarke in 2024 or 2025.

b. More than five total complaints during the previous ten years.

Complaints filed in previous years have not all been recorded fully or accurately. Furthermore, the Board previously relied on an outdated electronic database until a new system was implemented in 2023. At that time, the former Inspector General attempted to migrate historical data into the new system; however, the migration was incomplete, and the resulting data is neither comprehensive nor fully reliable.

Further complicating the data record, there were significant gaps where no inspector general was overseeing investigations or tracking data. An Interim Inspector General was hired for the first time on April 22, 2021, following the 2020 amendment to the CPRB Ordinance. That Interim Inspector General served for less than a year and worked part-time. The first permanent Inspector General was hired on January 13, 2022, and resigned in April 2024, with periods during that tenure also spent working part-time. The current Inspector General was hired in November 2024 and has served full-time in that role for the past 14 months.

Due to staffing limitations and updates in data systems, the metrics and methods for tracking complaints have changed over time. As a result, data before November 2024 might be incomplete or inaccurate.


This issue has now been resolved by establishing a fully staffed Office of Inspector General, which includes a full-time Inspector General and an Assistant Inspector General, along with standardized procedures implemented over the past 13 months to ensure data integrity moving forward.

Therefore, this part of the report does not include the required data identifying police officers with “more than five total complaints during the previous ten years” because the historical data needed to make that assessment is not sufficiently reliable.

4. The dollar value, if any, of settlements ordered and/or paid arising out of the citizen complaints, provided such disclosure does not violate a confidentiality agreement.

Based on knowledge and belief, the Inspector General states that the City of Hartford has not entered into any settlements directly arising out of a 2025 citizen complaint.

VI. Complaints Filed in 2024 & 2025

A. **Complaints Filed in 2024⁷**

In the calendar year 2024, a total of seventy-nine (**79**) citizen complaints alleging misconduct by Hartford Police officers were filed. Thirty-two (32) of these complaints were reviewed by the Civilian Police Review Board (CPRB) in 2024, while the remaining forty-seven (47) were reviewed by the CPRB in 2025.

B. **Complaints Filed in 2025**

In the calendar year 2025, a total of sixty-one (**61**) citizen complaints alleging misconduct by Hartford Police officers were filed. Fifty-one (51) of these complaints were reviewed by the CPRB in 2025, while ten (10) remain open and are pending investigation and CPRB review.

⁷ Although this report focuses on the 2025 calendar year, it also includes a summary of citizen complaints from 2024 because some of those cases were reviewed by the Civilian Police Review Board in 2025.

VII. Summary of Complaints Reviewed in 2025

A. Addressing the Backlog of Cases

At the start of 2025, the Board faced a significant backlog of cases, making it extremely difficult, if not impossible, to address newly filed complaints while continuing to investigate older matters that had accumulated over several years.⁸

To address this issue, the Board decided that a necessary and practical solution was needed – one that would allow the Inspector General to focus investigative resources on new complaints while resolving older cases that had become effectively moot⁹ due to the passage of time, including one case dating back to 2011.

The Inspector General compiled and presented to the Board a list of 28 complaints that were over a year old and considered moot due to their age. He recommended that they be closed administratively unless any complainant objects.

In June 2025, the Board approved sending notification letters to complainants involved in older cases, some of which had been pending for more than five years. The letters informed complainants of the Board's intention to close their cases, explained the reasons for that decision, and provided an opportunity for them to respond and request that their cases remain open and continue despite the issue of mootness.

The Inspector General sent letters to all identifiable complainants whose complaints were considered moot; however, no complainant responded or requested to have their

⁸ The Internal Affairs Division has consistently assigned about six investigators to handle incoming complaints over the past several years. In contrast, the CPRB has gone through periods where it lacked a full-time investigator and had to depend on contracted investigators for extended times to investigate complaints and present cases to the Board. This imbalance in investigative resources created a backlog, making it hard for the CPRB to keep up with incoming complaints. That issue has now been fixed. The CPRB now has a full-time Inspector General (hired in November 2024) and a part-time Assistant Inspector General (hired in August 2025) dedicated to investigating complaints for the Board.

⁹ Unfortunately, due to circumstances beyond the CPRB's control (see footnote above), the Board was unable to investigate certain cases before the Chief issued final decisions in those matters. As a result, even if the CPRB were to conduct an independent review and reach a different conclusion, no further action could be taken because the cases had already been officially closed by the Hartford Police Department. Reopening such cases would likely conflict with the Hartford Police Union's Collective Bargaining Agreement and could raise concerns under established legal principles of fairness and finality.

case continued.¹⁰ Without any request to proceed with an investigation, the Board officially closed 28 cases listed below due to mootness or, in some cases, because the complaints were anonymous and could not be investigated.


C. 2025 Complaints

Of the sixty-one (61) complaints filed in 2025, seven (7) were withdrawn, two (2) involved matters over which the Civilian Police Review Board (CPRB) lacks jurisdiction, and ten (10) remain pending and under investigation. As a result, 42 complaints were heard and voted on by the CPRB to determine whether the allegations against Hartford Police officers should be sustained or not sustained.

has occurred, even if no formal citizen complaint has been filed. The Board exercised this authority and initiated the complaint in 2023. However, by 2025, circumstances had changed such that withdrawal of the complaint and administrative closure of the matter were warranted.

D. All Complaints Reviewed in 2025

In 2025, CPRB reviewed a total of 98 citizen complaints—forty-seven (47) filed in 2024 and fifty-one (51) filed in 2025.
