

EMERGENCY ORDER REGARDING Food and Ice Cream Vendors Operating In THE CITY OF HARTFORD

WHEREAS, on June 17, 2020, issued an Emergency Order regulating the hours of operation of Food or Ice Cream Vendors operating in the City of Hartford, pursuant to Sec. 27, Division 4 of the Hartford Code of Ordinances during the period of the Emergency Declaration issued by Governor Lamont on March 10, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Governor has extended said Emergency Declaration and all Executive Orders and Sector Rules issued pursuant thereto through February 9, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the public health concerns that gave rise to the previous issued Emergency Order still exist.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED AND ORDER that, pursuant to the powers and duties granted in the Connecticut General Statutes and the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Hartford, and in accordance with the advice from the City's public health officials, the Emergency Order issued on June 17, 2020, which is attached and it's terms and conditions are incorporated herein, is extended through February 9, 2021, unless such Order is terminated or extended on or before said date.

IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that this order will made publicly available for inspection and review in the Office of the Town Clerk of the City of Hartford, conveyed to the Court of Common Council through its President, Maly D. Rosado, and shall be posted on the City of Hartford website.
